We are thankful for the opportunity to teach and train your children and are currently making plans for the fall term. Re-enrollment of our current students went well in February and we have already begun enrolling new students for this fall. We still have openings in each grade (at the time of this writing), but K3, K4, K5, and 7<sup>th</sup> grade are nearly full. If you have children that you plan to re-enroll, you should do so soon. If you know your child is not returning, we would appreciate a call to let us know. It will help us with planning. The \$50 matriculation fee guarantees a space for your child next year and may be paid as long as spaces are available and your account is current.

**SUMMER SCHOOL** begins June 7 and ends July 21. This is for students who did not successfully complete a grade (3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>) or a course (9<sup>th</sup>- 12<sup>th</sup>), students who need enrichment, or students who need to get on track in order to graduate at the scheduled time. More information and the registration form will be included in the May letter. At least ten students must be enrolled before we can offer summer school.

**ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY** for the fall sports (soccer and volleyball) is determined by the grades from fourth quarter, which begins March 15. Students in grades 6-11 who may want to participate next fall should be reminded of this. Please see the Athletic Handbook for a description of eligibility requirements. **SUMMER DAY CARE** is available for current students and new students who are enrolled for the 2010-11 year. The summer rate is \$2.60 an hour as it is now, and there is a \$75 cap per week, which means anything over 28 hours of Day Care will cost you nothing extra. This should be a big help to those who need care all summer. Information regarding special activities and the summer schedule will be sent home with the students before the end of school. Next year's rate for Day Care will increase ten cents to \$2.70 per hour.
