FINANCIAL INFORMATION FOR 2025-26

Sumter Christian School

PAYMENT METHODS: Sumter Christian School has contracted again with FACTS Tuition Management for the 2025-26 school year. The FACTS website is https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/4H9WV (a link to this site is on the school's website). New parents should set up their accounts immediately after enrolling a child. Several payment dates are available for monthly plans. There is an annual fee of \$55 per family (charged by FACTS on the first payment made). The fee is \$20 for the annual or semester plan, and the school will pay the fee for either of the \$20 plans (and continue to give the 3% discount for the annual plan as we have in the past).

MATRICULATION This reservation fee is due upon enrollment. The enrollment period begins in January and continues year-long as spaces are available. This fee reserves your child's space for the year and covers processing costs. The fee is \$60 for all students. Returning parents will pay the matriculation fee when they re-enroll through FACTS.

REGISTRATION (due by June 10 or upon enrollment or re-enrollment if registering after June 10) This charge covers achievement testing, library acquisitions, furniture, equipment (instructional and playground), summer maintenance, and membership in the South Carolina Association of Christian Schools (SCACS) and American Association of Christian Schools (AACS). These organizations provide legal oversight, certification for our teachers, and accreditation for the school. The fee is \$180 per student for preschool, \$240 per student for grades K-8, and \$280 for grades 9-12. The registration fee is assessed to your account and posted on June 1.

TUITION The tuition, usually paid in 11 payments July through May, pays for faculty and staff salaries and benefits and the daily operation of the school. The annual cost of tuition is as follows:

Preschool	\$3,388(\$308 per month, July through May or \$339 August through May if enrolling after July 1)
Kindergarten	\$4,092(\$372 per month, July through May or \$409 August through May if enrolling after July 1)
Grades 1-5	\$4,928(\$448 per month, July through May or \$493 August through May if enrolling after July 1)
Grades 6-12	\$4,950(\$450 per month, July through May or \$495 August through May if enrolling after July 1)

A late fee of \$35 is assessed each month the payment is late.

DISCOUNTS Two students in the same family living at the same address and being billed as one account receive a 5% discount on the annual tuition; three receive 17%; four or more receive 30%. There is no discount on the matriculation and registration fees. A 3% discount is given on the annual tuition if it is paid in full before Open House (or at Open House). Active military families that are new to Sumter Christian School in 2025-26 receive a 10% discount on tuition (for the first year only). All families at SCS can receive referral discounts for students who enroll because of your recommendation. We have two referral incentives for current families; one is good before July 1 and the other is good from July until the first day of school. This is in addition to the multi-child discount.

BOOK FEES The prices for workbooks are published by June 1. Book fees must be paid by Open House since we cannot distribute books until they are purchased. The fee is assessed to the accounts in June so payments may be made in increments or all at once before Open House. Please see the page titled "Workbook and Class Fees" for the most current listing of these costs.

ATHLETIC FEES are due before the first game of the season. The seasons are divided into fall, winter, and spring sports. The fees are \$95 for each varsity sport and \$65 for each JV sport. If a parent has two or more children playing a varsity sport in the same season, the fee is \$65 for the additional varsity siblings.

DAY CARE Students in SCS who arrive for early care, stay for late care, or attend on days when the school is closed are charged an hourly rate of \$3.90 per child. There is an \$90 weekly cap during weeks that school is in session and a \$130 weekly cap during weeks when school is not in session. TARGET LEARNING CENTER (TLC) The fee is \$1,900 for one course and \$3500 for two courses. If a student takes three or more classes in TLC, the student will be considered a full-time TLC student. Tuition for full-time TLC students is \$9,400. There is no additional charge if full-time TLC students take a mainstream class. The TLC resource class and help class are \$300 each per year unless a student is a full-time TLC student. See the parent information sheet for other information regarding TLC.

OTHER FEES Class fees for courses that use the computer lab or science lab are due before the first day of school. A graduation fee is due for all seniors (\$85) and kindergartners (\$40) before their graduation day. The graduation fee for seniors covers the production cost of diplomas, diploma covers, and the honorarium for our commencement speaker. The fee for kindergarten covers the cost of the cap and gown and a reception after graduation. Returned checks incur a \$30 fee (personal checks are not accepted after two returned checks). A withdrawal fee of \$60 will be charged if a student withdraws after the first day of school. Students in preschool and kindergarten pay a \$70 supply fee, which provides items such as crayons, glue, construction paper, scissors, school box, tissues, etc. for the entire year. Payments made in the office via credit card or debit card will incur a 3% fee of the transaction amount (with a minimum fee of \$2).

REFUNDS Matriculation and registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. Workbook fees are refundable if the books are totally unused. Unused tuition is refundable and is calculated by prorating the daily rate of tuition (based on 180 days).

PAST DUES Parents whose accounts are 30 days in arrears must submit a written payment plan to the School Committee for their approval to maintain enrollment in Sumter Christian School. All records and report cards are withheld until tuition and all other school fees are paid in full. Students may not attend the first day of school unless the account is current.
